If you are coming to our Family BBQ and Disco this evening, the playground gates will be opened at 5pm. You will be given a ticket on the gate if you have ordered food.

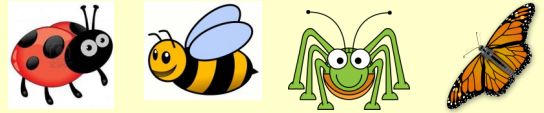
Please bring with you any snacks and drinks you would like, but please do not bring any alcohol as it is not permitted when children are on-site.
