Parents with DBS Checks

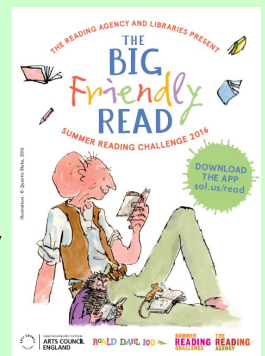
If you have a DBS check with the school please can you ensure that you have signed in this term, if you have not already done so.
