£5 Notes

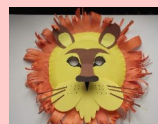
Please note that we are no longer accepting the old style £5 note.

Please let Mrs Tinkler know in the school office if your child's dietary requirements have changed.

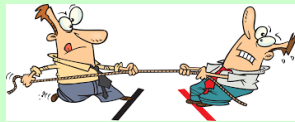
PTA News!
