Reminders

Coats in School

Now that the weather has turned colder and more unsettled, please ensure that your child comes to school with a waterproof coat with a hood everyday. On wet days please ensure that your child has suitable footwear as we do encourage the children to go outside everyday, unless it is very wet.

Warm clothing

In line with government guidance from 17th September, we must maintain good ventilation within the school. This means that windows and doors will be kept ajar where possible. At times it can be quite cool in the school and likely to get more so. We recommend that if your child feels the cold, you encourage them to wear a vest or other layers under their uniform.

Applications for Year R and Year 3 – September 2021

Year Two parents will need to apply for a Junior School place for September 2021. The online application system has now opened. You will need to complete this process even if your child is going to Walsh Junior School as allocation of a junior school place is not automatic.

If you are applying for a Year R space for a younger sibling, please ensure that you tick the sibling box, even if your older child is going to Walsh Junior School next September, as siblings are given priority.

Applying for a Junior School space or for Year R for September 2021

Year Two parents will need to apply for a Year Three space for their child for September 2021, even if they intend for their child to go to Walsh Junior School. For both Junior and Reception places it is imperative that you apply before the deadline of 15th January 2021 or you may not be offered one of your schools of choice. The on-line system will open on 2nd November and you can change your choice of schools any time up to 15th January 2021.

You will need to apply online if you have access to the Internet via the following website:

www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions - if you pay your Council Tax to Surrey County Council

www.hants.gov.uk/admissions - if you pay your Council Tax to Hampshire County Council

It does not matter if you are applying on the Hampshire website for a Surrey School or vice versa. After the closing date, the application information will be shared between the two counties.

If you need a paper copy of the application form for a postal application, please let the school office know. Similarly, if you need assistance completing the paperwork please let the school office know.

You can download the 'ParentComms' app to your mobile device to receive notifications about your application.

Once you have submitted your application you will receive a confirmation email.

Important dates to remember:

2nd November 2020 - You can apply online for a school place from this date.

15th January 2021 - Closing date for applications. However, the councils welcome early applications

16th April 2021 - School offer letters are posted first class. If you applied on-line you will be sent an email in the evening with the outcome and you can also view your school offer online.

30th April 2021 - You must confirm, by this date, whether you wish to accept or decline the place you have been offered.

Please note that if you are applying for a sibling to start in September 2021, and you have a child in our school or Walsh Junior School, you should tick the box which states that your child is a sibling as you will be given sibling priority status.
